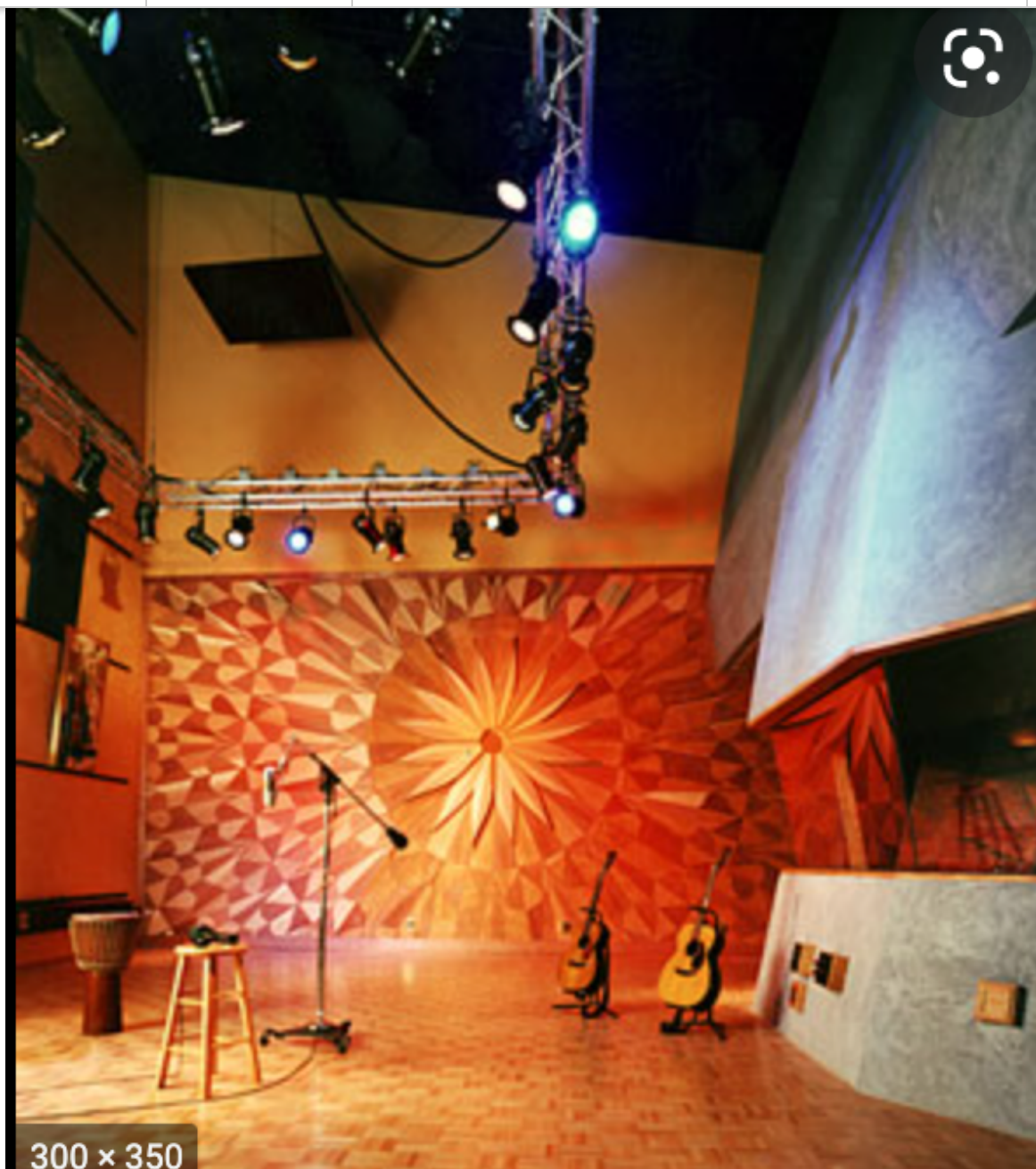

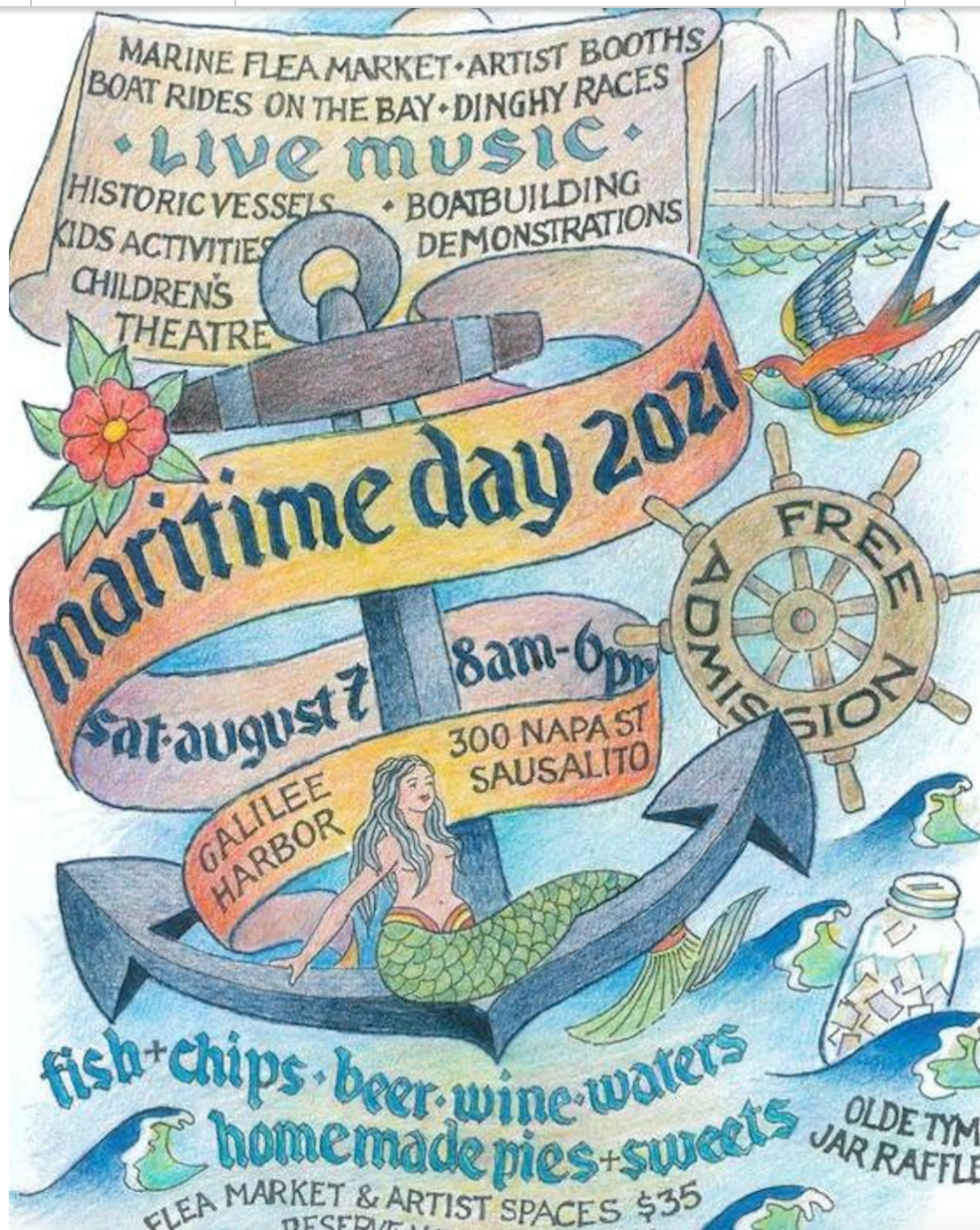

Bring your own drinks and nibbles ;)



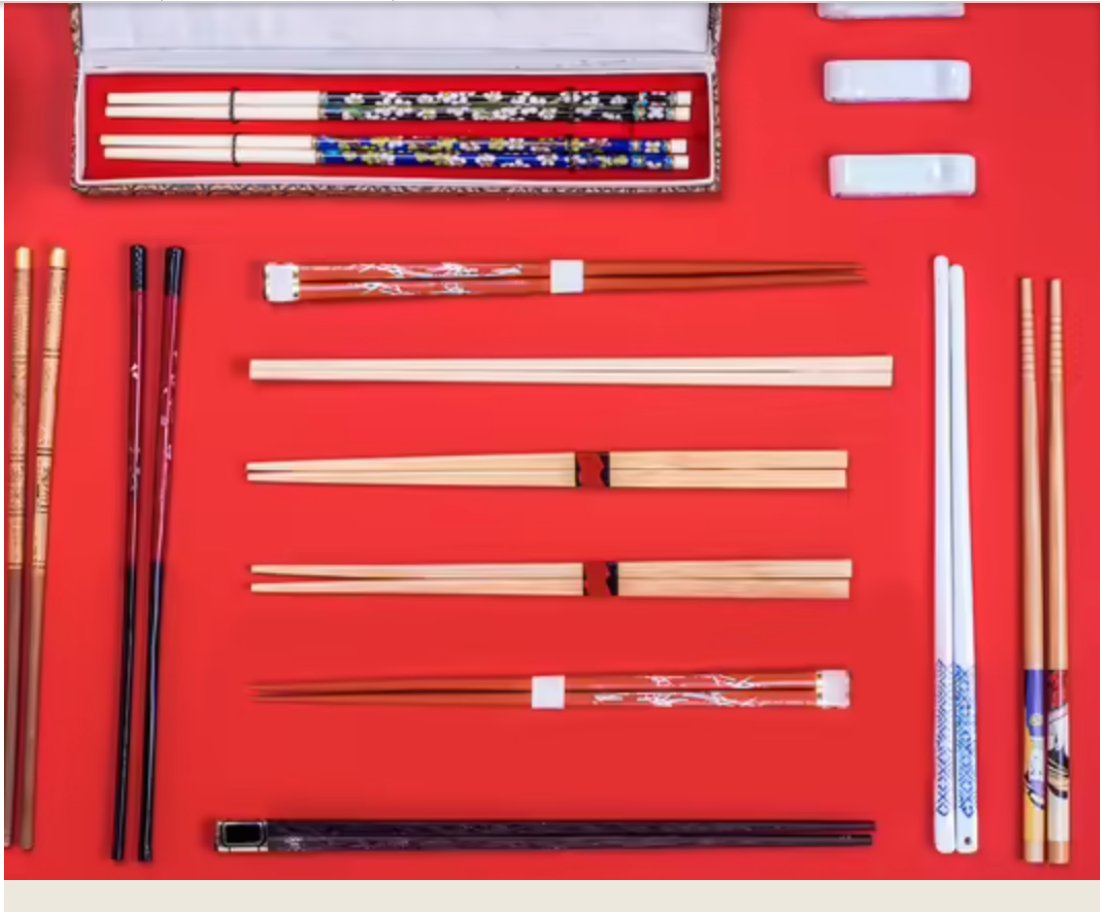


[The Age of Cathedrals: A Free Online Course from Yale University](#)
