

HEALTHCARE ADVOCACY VOLUNTEERS AVAILABLE

Have you ever gone to a doctor's appointment to consult on a condition and when you left thought about all the questions you meant to ask? Or when you left you tried to remember all the things the doctor told you? A Sausalito Village Healthcare Advocate can help you in these situations. Our Advocates are trained healthcare professionals and available to accompany you to doctor's visits. They can:

- Help you figure out and write down what questions you want answered before the visit.
- Can take notes for you during the visit, documenting what was discussed and the answers/recommendations given.
- Can insure that all the questions are answered to your satisfaction and that your wishes are respected.
- After the visit, can review the notes with you to help you to understand exactly what you were told and what your next steps might be
- And can accompany you on any additional or follow up visits.
- All of the information they receive in this role will be kept in strictest confidence.

If this is something that you would find helpful, please contact the Concierge to request to have a Healthcare Advocate contact you.

This is just one aspect of what the Healthcare Advocacy Committee can help you with. If you have other questions regarding what is available, please contact our Concierge, Connie at 415-332-3325 and ask her to have an Advocate contact you.
