Paris Café Terraces Finally Open

Yesterday café, bar and restaurant terraces all over Paris opened for the first time since the Coronavirus pandemic closed them down without warning at midnight on March 14th. I went for a stroll around my neighborhood at dinnertime to see who was open and who remained closed, and it seemed at least 75% of the places in the 13th around Place Jeanne d'Arc and Bibliothèque were open, including the outdoor seating areas of Station F's food Italian food court, La Félicita. City Hall is temporarily allowing terraces to take up more of the public space than usual, including sidewalks and parking spaces, to make up for the loss of indoor seating (which, already possible in the "Green Zones" in the rest of France, won't be allowed in Paris until June 22nd). All drinking and dining venues have to respect the strict Covid-19 rules for distance between tables, masks for servers or anyone not sitting in their seat, and for the terraces (to keep the peace with the neighbors): no noise, no music, and closing time is 10pm.
