The Smallest Reigning Man: The Incroyable Doll

The smallest of all menswear ensembles in <u>Reigning Men</u> is worn by a doll dressed in <u>the fashions of the French Revolution</u>. Dolls like this were not typically used for children's play, but were common novelty items for display and entertainment for adults in the 18th and 19th centuries. The doll wears a wide *bicorne* hat, an extremely wide bow at the neck, an exaggerated redstriped coat with blue-striped breeches, and a twisted stick called a Hercules club that doubled both as a fashionable accessory as well as weapon to bat


Millennials Show Us What 'Old' Looks Like



Opera is filled fathers! Giuseppe Verdi's oeuvre has seemingly countless fathers or father-figures, from his first opera *Oberto* to his last *Falstaff*. However, today we turn to the God of all fathers (Wait!....does that make him the "Godfather?"). In the finale of *Die Walküre* (the 2nd opera in **Richard Wagner**'s famous *Ring* cycle), the god

Wotan bids farewell to his beloved daughter Brünnhilde, sending her into an enchanted sleep. To protect her, Wotan calls on Loge, the Norse god of fire, to create a protective circle of fire around the rock where Brünnhilde sleeps. Only the bravest of heroes will be able to penetrate the fire (which happens in the cycle's 3rd opera).
