



Nominated 13 Tony Awards including "Best Musical," Lynn Ahrens & Stephen Flaherty's 1998 *Ragtime*, "dealt with discrimination and social inequality in the United States at the turn of the 20th-century. Sadly, this work of art could not be more relevant than today, as we struggle to instill American ideals of fairness and justice in our society and institutions. The more intractable these issues seem to be, the more we need art to help us talk about and overcome them." Based on E. L. Doctorow's 1975 novel by the same name, *Ragtime* uses song "to weave together stories ...from three very different perspectives - African Americans in Harlem, immigrants from Eastern Europe, and upper-class suburban whites. The differences of these groups are bridged and transcended by the popular music of the era."
