## Marin County Placed on Watch List for Increased COVID-19 Activity

Governor Gavin Newsom has added Marin County to a <u>monitoring list</u> of California counties that are being closely watched for increased COVID-19 activity.

Counties that are on the watch list for three consecutive days or more are required to close some indoor operations, such as indoor dining, where mixing of populations beyond households is occurring.

If Marin County remains on the watch list through Saturday, July 4, indoor dining in Marin could be required to close as early as Sunday, July 5. No other allowed activities in Marin County would be affected, as Marin has not gone as far as some counties in relaxing shelter-in-place orders.

The watch list is based on <u>COVID-19 data</u> and triggers a California Department of Public Health (CDPH) review of open business sectors and current COVID-19 containment strategies, among other factors. In adding Marin to the watch list, CDPH cited "elevated disease transmission, increasing hospitalizations, and limited hospital capacity," with the outbreak at San Quentin State Prison as a contributing factor.


Once CDPH closes an industry sector, the state has indicated that it will remain closed for a minimum of three weeks. Further, the state announced that it is forming <u>strike teams</u> to help patrol businesses that refuse to comply with COVID-19 safety measures.

"Now is the time for us to buckle down and be vigilant about adhering to key aspects of the shelter-in-place order," said Dr. Lisa Santora, Marin County Deputy Public Health Officer. "Wearing facial coverings, adhering to social bubble guidelines, and practicing social distancing are among those aspects. We've made gradual steps forward, and without our continued vigilance we will be forced to shut down portions of our economy again."


