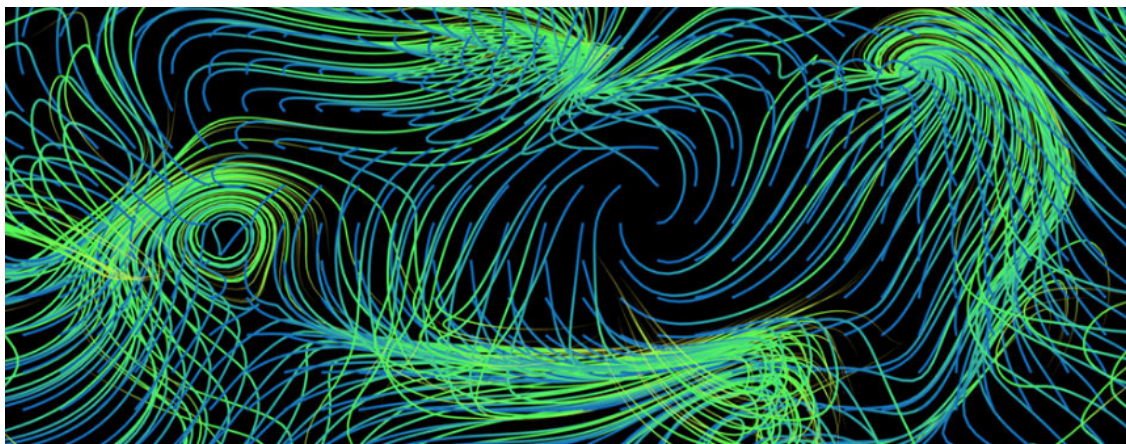
[Creative Time Comics](#)
