Although Marin is ranked purple for now, the California Department of Public Health has confirmed Marin will move into the second – or "red" – tier in an abbreviated timeline due in part to Marin County Public Health's high testing rates, and assuming Marin's case rate remains stable.

Marin's "purple" Tier 1 status means the county can reopen indoor shopping centers at maximum 25% capacity, and hair salons and barbershops indoors, beginning August 31. Those businesses will be held to the same public health

After nearly 100 years of welcoming guests to the Legion of Honor, Anna Vaughn Hyatt Huntington's *Joan of Arc* needed extensive restoration.

The French heroine's sword, which had detached in 2017, required a sturdy replacement. The original protective coating and patina of the life-size statue had degraded as well, resulting in an uneven and unprotected exterior. In collaboration with New York City's Citywide Conservation Program, our conservation team began the intricate restoration process, surrounding *Joan of Arc* with a cocoon of scaffolding as specialists used heat and acid to refinish her exterior.

This newsletter issue brings together multiple perspectives on preservation, from the conservation of art to the legacies we memorialize and those challenging how history gets written.
