The display features a 16-foot Christmas tree, a Hanukkah menorah, Kwanzaa greetings, and decorations on the plaza fountain.

The Christmas tree was donated by Councilmember Ian Sobieski, who was able to procure the tree with the help of Christopher Holbrook of the <u>Sausalito Farms</u> Christmas tree lot at the foot of Locust Street. City staff from the public works and parks and recreation departments helped to install the tree in its plaza location, and members of the City's <u>Economic Development Advisory Committee</u> did the decorating. Donations from community members provided the lights and ornaments.

The plaza fountain was decorated by volunteers from the <u>Sausalito Woman's Club</u>, for whom this is an annual event. The decorating team was led by Wera Musaus and Charlotte Mastrangelo, who also help maintain the rose garden at Gabrielson Park.

Sausalito's business community is also holding a limited number of special holiday events, with protecting the public health as the highest priority. Please make an extra effort to patronize Sausalito's shops and restaurants during this holiday season, as many local businesses are at risk.

Events include the <u>Sausalito Gingerbread House Tour</u> that began on December 1 and continues during the entire month of December. Fourteen Sausalito businesses are participating in the 2020 tour, which is presented by the Sausalito Chamber of Commerce.
