<u>Marin County Public Health</u> and health care providers have committed to focusing vaccination efforts across the county for residents age 75 and older, in a joint strategy designed to save lives.

To help Marin residents track when they may be eligible to receive a vaccine, the County is launching a new <u>online interest form</u>. Residents can answer a few questions to be subscribed to receive email or text message notifications when their turn has arrived and how to pursue a vaccine appointment. <u>The form</u> is available in English and Spanish on Marin County Public Health's <u>vaccine webpage</u>.
